Answers...

A1: Discernment.

A2: Balancing, empowering, cleansing, healing, enhancing, facilitating, expanding, accelerating, connecting, interpreting, aligning, translating, reconditioning, illuminating, transmuting, and polarizing.

A3: The second part of Specialization is what the crystals act upon, including which part or parts of the physical body, which subtle body, which chakras, which light frequencies, the soul, the light body, the higher-self, and even the Earth and its parts and locations.

A4: Almost, not quite!

A5: No!

A6: A crystal that works for consciousness expansion may be doing some reconditioning as a secondary and preliminary function, but the function-crossover of the vast majority of crystals is usually negligible.

A7: Because crystals are specialized!
